



## SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

**Please read carefully and follow all safety instructions. Your signature, on your waiver, confirms you have read this document and that you will follow all instructions.**

### VOLUNTEER SAFETY ALWAYS COMES FIRST!

- EVERY volunteer MUST have a completed and signed waiver, on file with KSLB to participate
  - Volunteer age, written signatures, and emergency contact information MUST be included
  - All volunteers, under age 18, must have a registered adult (over age 21) volunteer with them
- WEAR: closed toe shoes, work gloves, light colored clothing
- BE ALERT: for fire ants, bees, snakes, alligators, poison ivy, poison oak, additional hazards, etc.
- RECOMMENDED: sunscreen and insect repellent
- DRINK: Plenty of water
- TAKE: Frequent breaks
- WORK: During daylight hours only and never alone
- STOP: Cleanup immediately if lightning, heavy rains, or storms are present
- AVOID: Overexertion and overheating
- Working near water: Be extremely careful: Don't lean over bodies of water or get too close to the edge
- WASH: Your hands thoroughly when finished
- WATCH: children closely
- PARK: your car in the parking lot, not on the roadway or grass
- DON'T: Use heavy equipment or power tools
- DON'T: Do anything that could endanger yourself or others
  - If it feels unsafe, to you, it probably is
- DON'T: pick up hazardous items: needles, sharp objects, pesticides, batteries, etc.
  - Please request collection in your cleanup report
- DON'T: pick up or move animal carcasses
  - Please request collection in your cleanup report
- DON'T: try to move a large, unsafe, or heavy object
  - Please request collection in your cleanup report
